GUIDELINES AT **merritt clubs**

All members and users are responsible for following guidelines set forth. Failure to follow guidelines may result in being asked to leave. Please support our staff and their requests. Please know that they are here to help enforce safety requirements. These guidelines are subject to change as updates are available from government regulations.

CANTON ROOFTOP POOL:

HOURS: (see website for full hours)

May 1 - May 30: Open Friday - Sunday

May 31 (Memorial Day) - Sept 6 (Labor Day): Open daily

REGISTER FOR TIME SLOTS VIA THE APP:

- Must always register
- Morning time slots open at 7am, afternoon slots open at 9am

FORT AVENUE POOL:

HOURS: Open daily starting May 1 (see website for full hours)

REGISTER FOR TIME SLOTS VIA THE APP:

- Must register on weekends only May 1 - 23
- Required on all days starting May 29
- Morning time slots open at 7am, afternoon slots open at 9am

WHITE MARSH POOLS:

(see website for full hours)

LAP POOL HOURS: Daily starting May 1

Open for lap swim ONLY until Family Fun Pool opens

FAMILY FUN POOL HOURS:

May 15 - 23: Open Saturday and Sunday

May 29: Open daily

REGISTER FOR TIME SLOTS VIA THE APP:

- Lap swimmers need to register for a slot if swimming at 10am or later
- Register always for the slot at the Family Fun Pool
- Morning time slots open at 7am, afternoon slots open at 9am

TOWSON OUTDOOR POOL:

HOURS: (see website for full hours)

May 15 - 23: Open Saturdays and Sundays

May 29: Open daily

REGISTER FOR TIME SLOTS VIA THE APP:

- Must always register
- Morning time slots open at 7am, afternoon slots open at 9am

ELDERSBURG FAMILY FUN POOL:

HOURS: (see website for full hours)

May 15 - 23: Open Saturdays and Sundays

May 29: Open daily

REGISTER FOR TIME SLOTS VIA THE APP:

- Must always register
- Morning time slots open at 7am, afternoon slots open at 9am

MEMBERS/POOL PATRON GUIDELINES:

- **Health Declaration:** Before using the facility, members will be required to complete a COVID-19 health declaration and waiver and acknowledge our policies. *Those who are sick or have experienced any symptoms of COVID-19 in the last 72 hours should not come to the pool for any reason.*
 - o Members will be required to sign in and out before and after each visit.
- **Pool Reservation:** Unless you are doing early morning lap swim at White Marsh or using the Fort Avenue pool prior to May 22nd, all other outdoor pools require a reservation on the Merritt Clubs App. To learn how to make a reservation, [click here](#). Members will not be permitted to book more than one time slot per day.
- **Members must bring their own towels.**
- **Physical Distancing:** Members must maintain at least 6 feet of physical distance while in the pool, the clubs' grounds, and when entering and exiting the facility. Members may only sit with members of their family/household. There should be no congregating in the restrooms.
- **Face Mask Policy:** Will be following local government mandates, policies or subject to change based on location.
- **Swim Diapers:** Non-potty-trained children can only use the baby pools (leisure pool at Canton) with swim diapers and diaper covers. Non-potty-trained children are not allowed in the main outdoor pools.

GUESTS ARE NOT ALLOWED DURING WEEKENDS AND HOLIDAYS, THESE ARE FOR MEMBERS ONLY.
