FAMILY FUN POOL SEASON SCHEDULE

REGULAR SEASON HOURS:

May 29 – September 6

Monday – Saturday 10:00am – 8:00pm

Sunday 10:00am – 7:00pm

WEEKENDS ONLY:

September 11 – 12

Saturday 10:00am – 7:00pm

Sunday 10:00am – 6:00pm

SWIM TEST REQUIREMENTS

All children 13 and under must take a swim test in order to swim in the deep end and use the blue slide in addition to meeting the height requirement.

Swimmers who have passed the swim test will receive a colored wristband that must be worn at all times while at the pool. If you lose or forget to bring a swim band you will need to purchase another for \$2.00.

- Swim the length of the pool without stopping or assistance on top of the water
- Tread water for 1 minute
- Float on their back for 1 minute

Parents must stay in the water if their child is a non-swimmer and needs to wear a Coast Guard flotation device.

In order to have a safe and fun summer, we remind parents to review these safety rules with their children. The family fun pool has many features and attractions. It is imperative for parents to keep a close eye on their children at all times. The river channel and vortex are moving water that can pull a child away from the wall. It is important that your children do not go past where they can stand if they are not swimmers. Parents must stay in the water if their child is a non-swimmer and needs to wear a Coast Guard flotation device. Any questions, please see the lifeguards.

POOL RULES

- No running
- If no lifeguard is on duty, swimming is not allowed.
- Everyone 13 years and under must pass "deep end" test in order to use slides and go past the 5 foot section
- Spitting or blowing the nose is prohibited while in the pool.
- Smoking is not allowed.
- Glass is prohibited in the pool area.
- Appropriate swim wear must be worn in the pool.
- Only potty trained children are allowed in the lap pool.
- Non-potty trained children must wear a water diaper and tight bathing suit over it. They will be allowed to use the baby pool and fun pool only.
- Only Coast Guard approved flotation devices allowed.
- Diving is allowed only in designated areas.
- Kick boards, Fins, Aqua Weights are for exercise and classes only.
- Parents must stay in the water if their child is a non-swimmer and needs to wear any PFD (life jacket)
- Children 10 years and older can stay at the pools without a parent at the pool (parent must be at the club) once they pass a swim test administered by the lifeguard.
- Fun pool and deck opens at 10:00am. Reserving chairs prior to 10:00am is not allowed.
- Please rinse off in the shower before entering pool.
- The club accepts no liability for the injury, death, or loss associated with the use of the pool, e.g. articles of clothing, valuables, etc.
- Crude and/or inappropriate language and behavior is not permitted.
- Adult sunbathing is allowed prior to 10:00am ONLY on the deck adjacent to the bathrooms.
- Changing of pool diapers on deck is prohibited.

SLIDE RULES

- You must wait your turn behind the red tape
- Only 1 person may go down the slide at a time
- No head first or backwards entry allowed from slides
- You must be 3 years or older to go down the red slide

Merritt Clubs reserves the right to make changes to these rules at the lifeguards and management's discretion.

KIDDIE POOL RULES

- Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times
- This pool is intended for children 4 years old and under
- Non-potty trained children must wear a swim diaper.
