

Kids Club Rules

- Our Kids' Club is for the convenience of members while using the club. Our well-designed, modern facility is available for children the following ages: 8 weeks – 12 years
Only one visit per child (children) is permitted daily
- Children under the age of 1 year can visit the Kids' Club for 1 ½ hours. Children over the age of 1 year can visit for up to 2 hours.
- Staff cannot feed infants or change diapers.
- Parents must remain on the premises while children are signed into the Kids' Club. Outside jogging is not permitted.
- For the safety of all children, bottles, cups, food and snacks are not permitted in the Kids' Club.
- Children must have clean diapers upon entering the Kids' Club.
- All children's belongings should be labeled.
- No toys from home are to be brought into the Kids' Club.
- For safety reasons, children checked into the Kids' Club will only be released to the parent or parents that are on their bar code. To protect your child please have your child's barcode to check out your child.
- Once a child is checked into the Kids' Club, he/she will not be permitted to leave unless properly checked out by their parent.
- If a child is upset or uncomfortable for a period of ten (10) minutes or longer, the Staff has the option to request parental assistance.
- All children must wear shoes and socks while in the Kids' Club. Please be considerate of the health of all the children in the Kids' Club.
- If a child is ill, please DO NOT bring him/her to the Kids' Club. If your child has been kept home from school, has a fever of 100 or above, has a runny nose with yellow or green discharge, a rash or has been on antibiotics for less than 24 hours, they will not be accepted into the Kids' Club. If your child has an allergy or hay fever, please bring a note from your doctor so we do not confuse these symptoms with those of a cold or flu. Staff has authorization and obligation to deny use of the Kids' Club to sick children.
- Well-behaved children are always welcomed in our Kids' Club. Incidents that require discipline and compromise the safety of other children may result in a minimum three-day suspension from the Kids' Club and its programs. Appropriate action will be determined on a case-by-case basis by the Director of the Kids' Club and General Manager.



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
